

The 1,000 gallon allocation effective September 1, 2022 means

...if you still use 3,000 gallons a month, your bill will increase by \$20.00. For every 1,000 you go over the allocation, it is \$5.00 for the water, and \$5.00 for the sewage equaling \$10.00 per 1,000 gal over.

For those whose usage is usually 2,000, (their extra cost is \$10.00),

For anyone using 3,000 gallons or more should expect no more than a \$20.00 increase ABOVE what they normally would be paying.

Effective September 1, the utility bill will look like this:

Over by 2,000 gal.	<u>If Usage is 3,000 gallons-</u>	\$ 5 Water x 2: \$ 5 Sewage x 2-	\$ 45.00 Water: \$42.00 Sewage \$16.04 Trash=	<u>\$103.04 Total Monthly bill</u>
Over by 3,000 gal.	<u>If Usage is 4,000 gallons-</u>	\$ 5 Water x 3: \$ 5 Sewage x 3-	\$ 50.00 Water: \$47.00 Sewage \$16.04 Trash=	<u>\$113.04 Total Monthly bill</u>
Over by 4,000 gal.	<u>If Usage is 5,000 gallons-</u>	\$ 5 Water x 4: \$ 5 Sewage x 4-	\$ 55.00 Water: \$52.00 Sewage \$16.04 Trash=	<u>\$123.04 Total Monthly bill</u>
